The residents that have been contacted about water drainage in this area, are very frustrated with the lack of understanding of the problems and potential solutions to the stormwater issues in our area by city personnel. This is not a problem of a few residents that appear on maps we have been given. This is a regional problem in the Greenfield neighborhood. We have lived here since 1979, so we are well aware of the situation. We have been made out to be the cause of the stormwater problems, when we are more of a victim of the issues because we happen to live at the bottom of two hills, one to the north and one to the south, and also have homes behind us at higher elevations. All the residents in these higher areas have stormwater that runs off towards the lower elevations near and around the Curry Court area and some of the residences on Syene Rd.

In regard to a Sump Pump Collection System:

- We do not have standing water in our ditch along the west side of Syene Rd.
- Not all homes have sump pumps, but the ones at the lowest points do.
- We do have a sump pump at our residence, but it immediately pumps into a culvert under a driveway and then goes a couple of feet before emptying into the culvert that goes under Syene Rd to the vacant property across the street.
- A sump pump collection system would do us no good and we would not connect to one. We do not have a problem with it flowing as it moves thru culverts on our side of the road. The problem is across the road and for residences on Curry Court. We all need this stormwater to flow beyond Curry Court. It is currently stagnantly blocked at properties by the railroad tracks at the end of Curry Court.
- We should not be singled out and assessed for some type of solution to this stormwater problem just because we have to pump everyone else's stormwater in the neighborhood across the street. This should be a regional problem to be fixed and therefore paid for by city tax dollars.

All the 42 years we have lived here, we have continued to put up with this situation. It is probably caused by poor planning years ago when development occurred. However, Fitchburg has never seemed to see the residences outside the urban service area as a priority to fix problems. We are just as much a resident of Fitchburg as the expensive homes in urban areas.

Up until now, nothing we seem to try and explain to those researching this problem at the city, seem to be heard. We lived with this for years. We are not willing to be assessed and pay for poor development and planning on Fitchburg's part. We also feel the stormwater problem is a regional one and not an assessable fix for the residents that get the brunt of the problem.
