



McKee Road Reconstruction Public Information Meeting

Commerce Park Drive to Seminole Highway

A Public Information Meeting (PIM) has been scheduled for **Wednesday, September 20, 2017 at 7:00 pm** to discuss the McKee Road Reconstruction project, which extends for a length of 3,200 feet; from Commerce Park Drive to Seminole Highway. The meeting will be held in the Council Chambers at Fitchburg City Hall, 5520 Lacy Road.



This PIM will consist of a presentation to review the goals of the project, schedule, proposed improvements, and a review and discussion of 3 typical section alternatives that are being considered. The public will have the opportunity to view exhibits, ask questions and provide input on the typical section alternatives.

This project will maintain a 4-lane divided road on McKee Road, an underpass of the Badger State Trail where it crosses McKee Road, the addition of turn lanes at intersections, and will consider alternative bicycle and pedestrian accommodations along the length of the reconstruction limits.

The Badger State Trail crosses the project and is considered a public park area [Section 4(f) properties]. The project will include a grade-separated crossing for the Badger State Trail, improving safety and convenience for trail users and drivers on McKee Road. Negative impacts are not anticipated to the trail but temporary easements may be needed to accommodate grading and a temporary

detour of the trail will likely be required during construction. The project team is seeking your input on any concerns individuals may have with how the project is impacting these resources.

Persons with a concern for or knowledge about historic buildings and structures and archaeological sites are encouraged to attend this meeting or provide comments to the City about these sites.
