Shred Event Information

- Customers can bring in the equivalent of up to three boxes of paper or 3 bags of paper = 50 pounds.
 - Plastic bags cannot be shredded; it is preferred that customers bring their material in paper bags.
- All material must be paper products only (file folders, checks, junk mail, old tax forms, etc.).
 - Staples, paper clips, and rubber bands do not need to be removed.
- Materials Not Accepted:
 - No Three ring binders
 - No Hanging file folders
 - Paper will need to be removed before being put in the shredding cart
 - No media such as CD's floppy discs, tapes, or credit cards
- Confirmation of destruction will need to be given to each customer that brings information in to be shredded.
- The shred events are open to the public. All events will be posted at pellitteri.com and keepitconfidential.com.

Electronic Recycling Information

- Most items can be recycled at no cost to the customer.

Items we will recycle with no recycling fees

- CRT/Flat Screen Monitors: \$20 Each
- CRT/Flat Screen TV's 29" and Under: \$20 Each
- CRT/Flat Screen TV's 30" to 49": \$40 Each
- CRT/Flat Screen TV's over 50"/Console/Projection: \$60 Each
- Large appliances will not be accepted at this event including the following examples:
 - Mini fridges
 - AC units
 - Refrigerators
 - Stoves
 - Washers and dryers
 - Treadmills
 - Lawn Mowers

Medrop Information

HOW TO USE MEDDROP

- To dispose of medications in the MedDrop drop boxes, please bring your unused or expired medication and a Ziploc or other resealable bag to the MedDrop police department.
- Empty contents of pill bottles into a Ziploc/storage bag at the police station and recycle your pill bottles, either by taking them home with you, or placing in the container provided at the police station. Block out personal information before recycling.
- Leave liquids, gels or creams in their original containers and place them in a Ziploc/storage bag
- Place sealed Ziploc/storage bags into the MedDrop box
- A list of items accepted for disposal at MedDrop drop boxes is listed below

WHAT YOU CAN GET RID OF AT MEDDROP

- Prescription Medicine (pills, liquids, creams, powders & patches)
- Over-the-Counter Medicine (pills, liquids, creams, powders & patches)
- Medications for Pets
- Vitamins
- Medication Samples
- Nebulizer Solution
- Inhalers

- *Illegal drugs cannot be disposed of in the drop box. However, you may bring illegal drugs to the police station and turn them over to authorities, no questions asked.

Do Not Bring

- IV Bags
- Oxygen Tanks
- Nebulizer Machines
- Thermometers
- Sharps, Epi-pens or anything with a needle or lancet
