



2020- BULK WATER PERMIT APPLICATION

Permit Applications must be completed and returned to the Fitchburg Utilities office located at: 5520 Lacy Rd. Authorization to use water is provided once we return your application with your permit number. Submit your permit either in person at City Hall, by Email: Utility@fitchburgwi.gov or by Fax: 608-270-4212.

Per Tarriff rate schedule BW-1 dated 6/8/2016: Permit Fee - \$35.00 plus \$3.73 per 1,000 gallons

To avoid paying any penalties and/or fines.

Submit your permit when project is completed or by 1/7/2021. Which ever comes first.

BULK WATER PERMIT - This permit is for bulk water supplied to fill tank trucks from the water system. All water is metered.

1. Bulk haulers must load at the small single nozzle fill hydrant located at the corner of Lacy Rd and Jones Farm Rd. It is painted blue with a large sign in front of it. **PLEASE OPEN 4 TURNS ONLY.**
2. Bulk haulers must provide their own 2½” standard fire hydrant hose connection from the fire hydrant to the tanker.
3. Permittee shall have a copy of this permit in his or her possession and displayed at all times when withdrawing water.
4. This permit is only good for the year 2020. Return your permit when the project is completed or by January 7th, 2021.
