Lead-Acid Battery

How to Identify:

Large battery found in cars, trucks, and other vehicles. Sometimes marked "Lead Acid Battery."

Nickel-Metal Hydride Marked Ni-MH or Nickel-Metal Hydride	
Lithium Ion Marked Li-Ion or Lithium-Ion
